ORDINANCE No. 200.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE EMPLOYMENT OF ALIENS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of Kirkland.

Sec. 1. It shall be unlawful for any Officer or Agent of, or any Contractor with, the Town of Kirkland to knowingly employ any Alien upon or in connection with any work, or employment for the Town of Kirkland. And it shall be unlawful for any such Alien to accept employment with any Officer or Agent of, or any Contractor with the Town of Kirkland.

Sec. 2. Every person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of misdemeanor and upon conviction, thereof, shall be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). And any Contractor with the Town of Kirkland, violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to have forfeited his contract with the Town.
