ORDINANCE No. 202.

ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 200 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE EMPLOYMENT OF ALIENS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY THEREFOR."

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, Sec. 1. That section 1, of Ordinance No. 200, be in the same as hereby amended to read as follows:

It shall be unlawful for any Officer or Agent of, or any Contractor with the Town of Kirkland to knowingly employ any Alien, who did not serve in the Army of the United States, or with the Allies, in the late War with Germany, upon, or in connection with any work, or employment for the Town of Kirkland. And it shall be unlawful for any such Alien to accept employment with any Officer or Agent of, or any Contractor with the Town of Kirkland.
