ORDINANCE NO. 208

AN ORDINANCE for the preservation of public morality, peace, safety and good order in the Town of Kirkland, providing penalties for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND as follows:

- 1: That it shall be unlawful for any person to fire or discharge any cannon, gun, pistol, revolver or any fire-arm of any description, or fire or explode or set off any squib, fire cracker, torpedo or other thing containing powder or other explosive material within 400 feet of the King *within the limits of the town of Kirkland* ~~County Public Dock~~. *except on the 4th day of July, and at no time within 400 feet of the King County dock, at the foot of Kirkland Hill*
- 2: That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to go in bathing, or to loiter or use said dock for the purpose of diving off the same into the said waters, within 100 feet of said King County Dock.
- 3: That it shall be unlawful for any person or persons to stand or loiter in any public place, ~~or to~~ interfere with any person, or obstruct any travel thereon.

That any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by fine in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the town jail for a term not exceeding thirty days, or by such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court.
