

Ordinance Number 213.

An ordinance fixing the rates of interest on warrants of the Town of Kirkland.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland
Section I. From and after the passage of this ordinance all warrants presented to the Town Treasurer and not paid for lack of funds, shall be so stamped by him and shall bear interest at the rate of eight percent (8%) per annum from the date of such stamp until called by him.

Passed by the Town Council and signed by me in open council in authentication of the same, this 18th day of October 1920.
