

An ordinance amending ordinance number 176.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland

Section I. That Section 18 of Ordinance number 176 be amended to read as follows;

Water may be sold by the Town of Kirkland at either fixed rates or meter rates. Fixed rates for dwellings shall be five dollars per quarter, payable in advance on January first, April first/July first, and October first of each year. If paid before the first month of each Quarter, a rebate of fifty cents shall be allowed. If not paid by the fifteenth of the first month, water shall be shut off and shall not be turned on again until all arrears are paid together with a fee of fifty cents.

Section II.

Meter rates shall be as follows;

or less

For three thousand (3000) feet per quarter three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). For more than 3000 cubic feet six cents (.06) for each additional hundred cubic feet. If paid before the tenth day of the first month of each quarter a rebate of fifty cents will be allowed. If not paid by the fifteenth water will be shut off and will not be turned on again until all arrears are paid together with a fee of fifty cents. Meters will be installed at cost to water users.

Section III.

Section 19 shall be amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting the words Water shall be used for sprinkling ^{not} ~~only~~ when delivered through meters.
