An ordinance amending ordinance number 176.

Be it ordsined by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland Section I. That Section IS of Ordinance number 176 be amended to read as follows:

Water may be sold by the Town of Kirkland at either fixed rates or meter ratesfixed rates for dwellings shall be five dollars perquarter, payable in advance on January first , April first/July first, and October first of each year. If paid before the first month of each Tenth day of Quarter , a rebate of fifty cents shall be allowed. If not paid by the fifteenth if the first month /, water shall be shut off and shall not be turned on again until all arrears are paid together with a fee of fifty cents.

Section II.

For three themsand (3000) feet per quarter three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50). For more than 3000 cubic feet six cents (.06) for each additional hundred cubic feet. If paid before the tenth day of the first month of each quarter a rebate of fifty cents will be allowed. If not paid by the fifteenth water will be shut off and will not be turned on again until all arrears are paid together with a fee of fifty cents. Medters will be installed at cost to water users.

Section III.

Section 19 shall be amended by striking out the first work and inserting the words water shall be used for sprinkling each when delivered through meters.
