ORDINANCE NO. ~~217~~ ~~7~~

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE PUBLIC MORALITY, PEACE, AND GOOD ORDER OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, that it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to conduct a public card table, pool or billiard table, *between the hours* after twelve o'clock midnight; and seven o'clock a.m.

Providing further, that any person violating or failing to comply with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be punished with a fine in the sum of not to exceed one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the town jail not to exceed thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
