ORDINANCE NO. 223.....

AN ORDINANCE forbidding the use of loud, profane or obscene language, and the use or exhibition of any obscene literature in any park in ^{playfield, bathing beach, street or public place} the Town of Kirkland, and providing penalties for the violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for person to use loud, profane, obscene, boisterous or insulting language, or to be guilty of any disorderly, lewd or lascivious conduct of any kind in any park in ^{playfield, bathing beach, street or public place} the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person to exhibit, in any park in the Town of Kirkland, any obscene or indecent book, magazine, engraving, drawing or photograph, or any book, pamphlet, magazine, newspaper or other paper devoted to the publication or principally made up, of criminal news, police reports or accounts of criminal deeds or pictures or stories of deeds of bloodshed, lust or crime.

Section 3: Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine in any sum not exceeding one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the town jail for a term not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
