

AN ORDINANCE annexing certain territory to the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:-

Section 1. That there be, and is, hereby annexed and made a part of the Town of Kirkland the following described new territory situated outside of the present limits of said town, and which is now ~~owned~~ and used by said town for municipal purposes, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the north line of the city limits of Kirkland, at the intersection of the north line of Section 6, Township 25 N., Range 5 E.W.M., and the North-easterly marginal line of the Alley in Block 40, Blewett's First Addition to Kirkland, as shown upon the plat as of record in volume 6 of plats, page 81 1/2, records of King County, Washington, and running thence northwesterly along said easterly marginal line and said line produced and continuing along the easterly line of the Alleys in Blocks 41 and 42, said Blewett's First Addition to the North line of said Addition and the southerly line of Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Addition to the City of Seattle, Division #29; thence westerly along said line and said line produced to deep water in Lake Washington; thence southerly to the North line of the City limits of Kirkland to a point on the westerly production of the northerly line of said Section 6; thence easterly along said production and said line to the place of beginning, said Tract adjoins the present limits of the City of Kirkland on the North; situated in King County, State of Washington.

Section 2. That upon this Ordinance taking effect, said territory shall, in all respects, be subject to the Ordinance regulations of the Town of Kirkland in like manner as if the said territory had at all times been within the limits of said town.
