ORDINANCE NO. 233

An Ordinance establishing a Local Improvement General Fund.

Be it ordained by the council of the Town of Kirkland:

Sec. 1. There is hereby established in the city treasury a fund to be known as the Local Improvement General fund, into which may be paid or transferred from time to time by the city treasurer on the order of the council any balance remaining in the fund of any local improvement district after the payment of the whole cost and expense of such improvement and such other moneys as he may be authorized by existing laws to pay into such fund or be hereafter authorized by law.

Sec. 2. The moneys in the Local Improvement General fund shall be paid out as the city council may direct in accordance with law.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
