

RESOLUTION R-5188

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND  
ADOPTING THE CITY OF KIRKLAND UPDATED 2015-2020  
TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM.

1           WHEREAS, under RCW 35.77.010 the City is required to annually  
2 review and adopt a comprehensive six-year Transportation  
3 Improvement Program; and  
4

5           WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland Transportation Improvement  
6 Program has been updated for 2015-2020 in accordance with the State  
7 law requirements; and  
8

9           WHEREAS, the updated 2015-2020 Transportation Improvement  
10 Program is a planning tool for the development of transportation  
11 facilities within the City and includes traffic and street improvements  
12 and public transit investments; and  
13

14           WHEREAS, with respect to the provisions of RCW 35.77.010(2),  
15 the City Council finds that the update to the 2015-2020 Transportation  
16 Improvement Program identifies non-motorized projects for sidewalk  
17 and school walk route enhancements, and improvements to the Cross  
18 Kirkland Corridor, including trail components; and  
19

20           WHEREAS, the City Council finds the update to the 2015-2020  
21 Transportation Improvement Program is consistent with the  
22 Transportation Element of the City of Kirkland Comprehensive Plan; and  
23

24           WHEREAS, the annual adoption of the updated Transportation  
25 Improvement Program allows the City to apply for and receive various  
26 state and federal funds to implement transportation projects in the  
27 program; and  
28

29           WHEREAS, on March 1, 2016, the City Council conducted a public  
30 hearing and took public comment on the proposed update to the 2015-  
31 2020 Transportation Improvement Program.  
32

33           NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Council of the City  
34 of Kirkland as follows:  
35

36           Section 1. The City of Kirkland Updated 2015-2020  
37 Transportation Improvement Program is adopted as set forth in Exhibit  
38 A and Exhibit B which are incorporated by reference.  
39

40           Section 2. Copies of this Resolution and the 2015-2020  
41 Transportation Improvement Program, as set forth in Exhibit A and  
42 Exhibit B, shall be filed with the Secretary of the Washington State  
43 Department of Transportation as required by RCW 35.77.010.

46 meeting this 1st day of March, 2016.

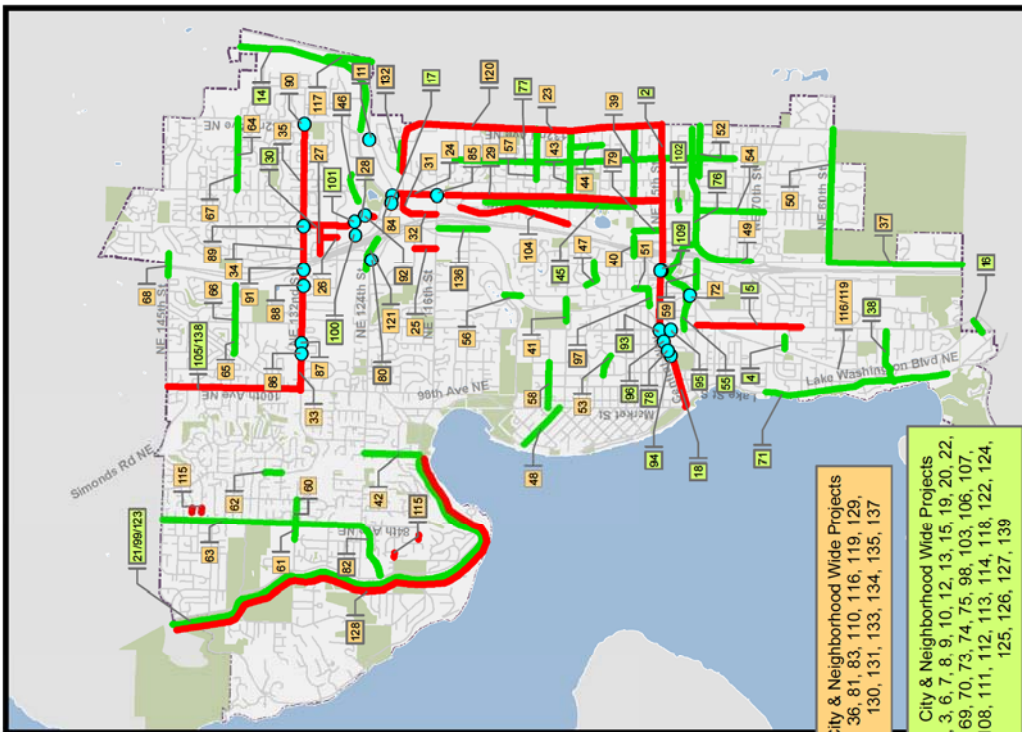
