

ORDINANCE NO. 244

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND CONFIRMING THE ASSESSMENT AND ASSESSMENT ROLL OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 72 FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF Waverly Street between Park Street and the alley which comes into Waverly Street at the South East corner of Lot 31 Block 7, Map of Kirkland, in the Town of Kirkland, by grading and putting in cement sidewalk on the North side of said Waverly street and such other work as may be necessary thereto including drains and a crossing at the intersection of Waverly street and Park street, under Ordinance No. 243, and levying assessments and the amounts thereof against the several lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property as shown on said roll, and establishing a Local Improvement fund, and fixing the date of the issuance of bonds.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the assessment ~~roll~~ and assessment roll of Local Improvement District No 72 for the improvement of Waverly street between Park Street and the Alley which comes into Waverly Street at the South East corner of Lot 31 Block 7, Map of Kirkland, by grading and putting in cement sidewalk on the North side of said Waverly Street and such other work as may be necessary thereto including drains and a crossing at the intersection of Waverly street and Park Street, all in the Town of Kirkland, under Ordinance No. 243, as the same now stands be, and the same is hereby in all things approved and confirmed.

Section 2: That each of the lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property shown upon said roll is hereby assessed to be specially benefitted by said improvement in at least the amount charged against the same and that the assessment appearing against the same is in proportion to the several assessments appearing on said roll. There is hereby levied and assessed against each such lot, tract, parcel of land or other property appearing upon such roll the amount finally charged against the same thereon.

Section 3: That for the purpose of this improvement there is hereby created and established a special fund to be called Local Improvement Fund, District No.72.

Section 4: Bonds required to be issued for this improvement will be issued at the time provided by law.

Section 5: This ordinance will be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.

NOTICE TO BIDDERS.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT sealed bids will be received by the undersigned Town Clerk of the Town of Kirkland, for the improvement of Waverly street between Park street and the Alley which comes into which comes into Waverly street at the south east corner of Lot 31 Block 7 Map of Kirkland by putting in cement sidewalk on the North side of said Waverly street and such other work as may be necessary thereto including a crossing at the intersection of Park street and Waverly street, in accordance with Ordinance No. 243 of said Town and the plans and specifications of the Town engineer which are now on file, and open to inspection, with the Town Clerk.

Said bids will be received up to 5:00 o'clock P.M. April 20 1925 at the office of the undersigned Town Clerk. Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check for ten per cent of the amount thereof made payable to the Town of Kirkland and the same to be forfeited to the Town in case the successful bidder fails to enter into a contract and furnish the bond herein provided for.

The successful bidder will be required to enter into a bond written contract pursuant to said bid and furnish a good and sufficient bond to the said Town conditioned for the faithful performance thereof, in an amount equal to the contract price for said work, all within ten days after the acceptance of said bid.

The Town Council reserves the right to refuse any and all bids

Special attention is called to the number of hours constituting a days work, under the State law.

The successful bidder will also be required to make all payments to the State of Washington, which may be required by reason of the "Workmans Compensation Act".
