ORDINANCE NO 247.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF Kirkland Avenue from Lake Avenue to the City Limits on the North Side, and from Blau's Chervolet CO. garage property on the south side to the State Aid Road, by putting in cement sidewalks and curbs; and the State Aid Road on the North side to the City Limits by putting in cement sidewalks, with culverts and proper crossings and grading for the same and such other work as may be necessary thereto, all in accordance with Resolution No. 108 of the Town of Kirkland, creating Local Improvement District therefore, and providing that payment for said improvement be made by special assessments upon the property in said district

BE IT ORDAINED By the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:-

Section 1. That Kirkland Avenue be improved from Lake Avenue to the City Limits on the North Side, and from Blau's Chervolet Co. garage property on the South side ^{by putting in cement sidewalks and curbs;} and the State Aid Road on the North Side ^{to the City Limits} by putting in cement sidewalks, with culverts and crossings and grading for the same and such other work as may be necessary therewith according to the plans and specifications therefore prepared by the Engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland, on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including the necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne and assessed against the property included in the district hereinafter created in accordance with law. The Town of Kirkland will not be liable for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement, except as herein provided.

Section 3. That there is hereby established a local improvement district to be called Local Improvement District No. 74 which said district is described as follows:-

" All property between the termini of said improvement immediately abutting upon that portion of the street or other public place on the North side of Kirkland Avenue between Lake Avenue and the City Limits on the North side, and from Blau's Chervolet Co. garage property on the South side to the State Aid Road and the State Aid Road on the North side to the City Limits as provided by law."

Section 4. That warrants bearing interest at the rate of 7% will be drawn on said improvement district and be payable from a fund known as local Improvement District Fund No 74 which warrants shall be redeemed by the collection of five annual instalments with interest at the rate of 7% per annum. ^{plus 5% penalty if not paid on the date.} These warrants shall be delivered to the contractor in payment for said work.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, approval and legal publication.
