ORDINANCE NO. 252

AN ORDINANCE, TO PROTECT THE PEOPLE OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND AND THE PUBLIC FROM VICIOUS DOGS AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE KEEPING OF SUCH DOGS.

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland, as follows:-

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm, company, or corporation, owning or having the care and control of any dog in the Town of Kirkland, which ~~has bit~~, or ~~has~~ been known to have bitten any person, or is vicious, to allow any such dog to run at large.

Section 2: It shall be the duty of any person owning, or having a dog under his control which has bit or has been known to bite any person in the Town of Kirkland, outside the enclosure of the owner, to kill or cause such dog to be killed within twenty-four hours after being notified by the Police Judge, or Town Marshal of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 3: Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined in a sum not less than fifty dollars or more than One Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment for a term of not more than thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4: Nothing contained in this Ordinance shall be construed as exempting such person liability in a civil action for or on account of damages caused by such dog biting or injuring ~~any~~ ^a person.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
