ORDINANCE NO. 254.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MICHIGAN AVENUE BETWEEN Oxford and Market St. by grading, graveling, and proper culverts and such other work as may be necessary thereto; and by putting in cement sidewalks on Michigan Ave. on the North side between Oxford and Bold St. and such other work as may be necessary thereto, all in accordance with Resolution No. 113 of the Town of Kirkland, creating Local Improvement District therefor and providing that the method of said improvement will be made by special assessment upon the property in said district.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL of the Town of Kirkland
Section 1. That Michigan Ave. be improved between Oxford and Market St. By grading, graveling, proper culverts and such other work as may be necessary thereto; and by putting in cement sidewalks on the North side of Michigan Ave. between Oxford and Bold St. and such other work as may be necessary thereto in accordance with the plans and specifications of the Town Engineer on file in the office of the Town Clerk.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement including all necessary and incidental expenses shall be borne and assessed against the property included in the district hereinafter created in accordance with law, the Town of Kirkland will not be liable for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement except as herein provided.

Section 3. That there is hereby established local improvement district to be called Local Improvement District No. 78 which said district is described as follows:-

" All property between the termini of said district or improvement, abutting upon, adjacent or approximate to said portion of the said street to a distance back from the marginal lines thereof as provided by law."

Section 4. That warrants bearing interest at the rate of 7% will be drawn on said improvement district payable from a fund known as Local Improvement District Fund No. 78; which warrants shall be redeemed by the collection of tax equal annual instalments with interest at the rate of 7% plus 5% penalty if not paid on due date. These warrants shall be delivered to the contractor in payment for said work.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, publication and approval as provided by law.
