ORDINANCE NO. 257

An ordinance providing for the takung and damaging of land and other property necessary for a system of water works for furnishing the Town of Kirkland and its inhabitants with an ample supply of water for all purposes, and for protecting such supply from polution, and for the ascertainment of the just compensation to be made for the property to be taken or damaged for such purpose.

Whereas, public necesity demands that certain land be taken and damaged for a system of waterworks for furnishing the Town of Kirkland and its inhabitants with ample supply of water for all uses and purposes and for the purpose of protecting such suply of water from polution; now, therefore

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:

Section 1. That the following described real property rights and privileges, in King County, State of Washington, be, and the same are hereby declared to be necessary and essential for a system of waterworks for furnishing the Town of Kirkland, and its inhabitants with an ample supply of water for all purposes and for protecting such supply of water from polution, and that all of said realestate rights and privileges be, and the same are, hereby appropriated, condemned, taken and damaged for said purposes, to-wit:

Parcel of land in the S.W. 1/4 of the S.E. 1/4 of Section 17. Tp. 25. N., R.5 E., W.M., containing 6.71 acres.

Begining on the ease line of the South West 1/4 of the South East 1/4, North 39 deg. 28 min. 20 sec. West from South East corner 882.82 ft. toplace of beginning, thence South 48 deg. 32 min. no sec. West266.00 feet thence North 44 deg. 42 min. 10 sec. West 360.00 ft. thence North 12 deg. o4 min. 10 sec. East 335.01 ft., thence North 53 deg. 29 min. 50 sec. East 360.84 ft. thence North 89 deg 08 min. 13 sec. East 430.56 ft. thence South 46 deg. 29 min. 20 sec. West 327.26 ft. thence South 30 deg. 36 min. 30 sec. West. 356.41 ft. thence South 39 deg. 55 min. 40 sec. East 125.80 ft. to place of begining.

Section 2. That the attorney for the Town of Kirkland in this matter be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to begin and prosecute the actions and proceedings, in the manner provided by law to comdemn, take, damage, and appropriate the lands and other property, rights and privileges necessary to carry out the provisions

of this ordinance

Section 3. That the purchase price of said property will be derived from the sale of bonds as authorized by ordinance No. 246 and the vote of the people of Kirkland at the special election held in the Town of Kirkland for that purpose on May 23, 1925

This Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
