AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND CONFIRMING THE ASSESSMENT AND ASSESSMENT ROLL OF LOCAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NO. 74, for the improvement of Kirkland, Ave. from Lake Ave. to City Limits and State Aid road from the intersection of Kirkland Ave and State Aid road to City Limits by putting in Cement sidewalks on Kirkland Ave. For the City Limits on the North side and from Blau Cheverolet Garage Property on the South side to the intersection of Kirkland Ave. and the State Aid road, and the State Aid road from Kirkland Ave on the North and East side to the City limits and on the South and West side from the intersection tion of the State Aid read and Kirkland Ave. to Jackson St. together with curb and gutter, and by grading and graveling Kirkland Ave. to the City limits and the State Aid road from the Intersection of Kirkland Ave to the City Limits, under Ordinance No. 261 as ammending Ordinance No. 256 as ammending Ordinance No. 247. and levying and assessing the amounts thereof afainst the several lots, tracts, parcels of land and other property as shown on said roll, and establishing a local improvement fund and fixthe date of the issuence of bonds.

Section 1. That the assessment and assessment roll of Local Improvement District No. 74 for the improvement of Kirkland Ave and the State Aid road by putting in cement sidewalks on Kirkland Ave. on the North side from Lake Ave. to the city limits and from Blau's Cheverolet Garage property on the South side to the intersection of Kirkland Ave. and the State Aid road and the State Aid road on the North and East side from Kirkland Ave. to the City limits and on the South and West side from Kirkland Ave. to Jackson street together with curb and gutter, and by grading and graveling Kirkland Ave. from Lake Ave. from Iske Ave to the City limits and the State Aid road from Kirkland Ave to City limits and such other

work as may be necessary thereto, all in the Town of Kirkland under ordinance No. 261 as ammending Ordinance No. 265 as ammending Ordinance No. 247 as the same now stands, be and the same is hereby in all things approved and confirmed.

Section 2. that each lot, tract, parcel of land and other property shown upon said roll is hereby declared to be specially benefitted by said improvement in at least the amount charged against the same and that the assessment appearing against the same is in propotion to the several assessments appearing upon said roll. There is hereby levied and assessed against each such lot, tract, parcel of land or other property appearing upon such roll the amount finally charged against the same thereon.

Section 3. That for the purpose of this improvement there is hereby created and established a special fund to be called Local Improvement Fund. District No. 74.

Section 4. That the town treasurer shall give notice of the collection of said assessments for a period of thirty days in the manner provided by law, and during said period said respective assessments herein levied, or any portion thereof, may be paid without interest; that all sums remaining unpaid after the expiration of said thirty day period may be paid in ten equal annual installments together with interest thereon at the rate of per cent per annum, payable annually, and that local improvement district bonds shall be issued against said district for the amount of such unpaid assessments, which said bonds shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, and be payable on or before twelve years from the date of issuance.

Section 5. This Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage, appreval, and publication as required by law.

If any bid reweived be accepted the deposits of all other bidders shall be the reupon returned.
