

ORDINANCE NO 266.

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF LAKE AVENUE, ON THE EAST SIDE  
From the Post Office Bldg. to Jackson Street by putting in a six  
foot cement sidewalk and curbing and paving from the curb to the  
present paving and such other work as may be necessary in connection  
therewith, all in accordance with Resolution No. 119 of the Town of  
Kirkland, creating a local Improvement District therefor, and providing  
that the payment of the improvement be made by special assessment up-  
on the property in said district.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1. That lake Ave. be improved on the East side from the  
Post Office Bldg. to Jackson Street by putting <sup>six foot</sup> in/cement sidewalk  
and curbing and paving from the curb to the present paving, and such  
other work as may be necessary thereto in accordance with the plans  
and specifications therefor prepared by the Town Engineer on file  
in the office of the Town Clerk.

Section 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement in-  
cluding all necessary and incidental expenses, shall be borne and  
assessed against the property included in the district hereinafter  
created in accordance with law, the Town of Kirkland will not be  
liable for any portion of the cost and expense of said improvement,  
except as herein provided.

SECTION 3. That there is hereby established a Local Improvement  
District to be called Local Improvement District NO 79, which  
said district is described as follows:

"All property between the termini of said district or  
improvement, abutting upon, adjacent or approximate  
to said portion of the street to a distance back from  
the marginal lines thereof as provided by law."

SECTION 4. That bonds bearing interest at the rate of seven  
per cent per annum payable on or before twelve years after date of  
issuance shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of this  
improvement, which bonds shall be redeemed by the collection of

special assessments against the property within the said improvement district payable in ten equal instalments with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum under the mode of "Payment by Bonds," as defined by law. these bonds shall be delivered to the contractor in redemption of warrants on the local improvement district fund issued on the estimates of the Engineer in the employ of the Town of Kirkland, or the Town of Kirkland may, at its election, sell said bonds and make such redemption in cash.
