ORDINANCE NO. 269

An Ordinance creating the Office of Garbage Collector, authorizing the Mayor of the Town of Kirkland to appoint such collector, and specifying the regulations under which the garbage will be collected.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND

SECTION 1. That there is hereby created the office of Garbage Collector, to be appointed by the Mayor.

SECTION 2. That said Garbage Collector will have full charge of the Garbage dump of the Town of Kirkland and be responsible to the Town of Kirkland for the use of the same.

SECTION 3. That said Garbage Collector will enter into a Bond in favor of the Town of Kirkland in at least the sum of \$500.00, or such other sum as the Mayor shall see fit, conditioned that he will faithfully perform the duties of his office, and save the town of Kirkland harmless from any damage or loss occasioned in the performance of his duties.

SECTION 4. That such garbage will consist of ashes and all dry refuse commonly classed as garbage, and must be kept dry and in cans by the owner.

SECTION 5. That said Garbage Collector can enter into a contract, or contracts, with the people of the Town of Kirkland for the collection of their respective garbage, and will be liable to the Town of Kirkland, and the people with whom he contracts for the faithful performance of his duties.

SECTION 6. That the Town of Kirkland will not be liable to the said Garbage Collector for wages, salary, or compensation for or on account of the Collection of Garbage, or to any employee hired by said Garbage Collector.

SECTION 7. This Ordinance will be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
