

ORDINANCE NO. 284

An Ordinance declaring that an emergency exists and estimating the amount of money required to meet said emergency and authorizing the payment thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND

SECTION 1: That an emergency exists at the Kirkland water shed caused by a ~~flood~~ ^{break} and the leaking of the dam, which endangers the water supply of the said Town, and greatly increases the possibility of loss of life and property by fire.

SECTION 2: That the restoration of the dam at said water shed caused by said accident to a condition of usefulness is necessary for public health and the existence of said Town.

SECTION # 3: That the estimated cost and expense of restoring said dam to a condition of usefulness is \$ 3000.00.

SECTION 4: That the Town Treasuere is hereby authorized to pay such warrants from any monies on hand in the town treasury in the fund chargeable with such expenditure. If at any time there shall be insufficient money on hand to pay any emergency warrant such warrant shall be registered and bear interest and be called in the same manner as other town warrants.

SECTION 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval and publication as required by law.
