ORDINANCE NO. 297

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 222.

Be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: That Section 17, of Ordinance 222 shall be amended to read as follows, to-wit: Water may be sold at either fixed rates or meter rates. Fixed rates for dwellings shall be five dollars per quarter of three months, payable in advance on January first, April first, July first and October first.

Meter rates shall be as follows, to-wit. For the first 1500 cubic feet or less per quarter, three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50), for more than 1500 cubic feet up to 5000 cubic feet, 10 cents, for each added 100 cubic feet ~~up to~~ ~~cubic feet~~ and from 5000 cubic feet <sup>up</sup> four cents (\$.04) for each added 100 cubic feet payable on the first day of January, April, July and October.

If payment is made during the first ten days of each quarter a rebate of fifty (50) cents will be allowed. If payment is not made by the fifteenth day of the quarter, water will be shut off, and not turned on again until all arrears are paid together with a fee of fifty (50) cents. In computing meter rates results ending in 1 or 2 cents shall be counted as 0. Results ending in 3, 4, 6, or 7, cents shall be counted as 5 cents. Results ending in 8 or 9 cents shall be counted as 10 cents.

Section 2: All Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
