## ORDINANCE NO. 299

AN ORDINANCE providing for the improvement of Clarckson Avenue, between Oxford and Bold Streets, by putting in four inch water mains, and such other work as me be necessary thereto, all in accordance with Resolution No. 144 of the Town of Kirkland creating local improvement district therefor.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland:SECTION 1. That Clarckson Avenue between Oxford and Bold
Streets be improved by putting in four inch water mains, and such other work as may be necessary thereto, according to the plans and specifications of the Engineer in the employ of the said Town.

SECTION 2. That the cost and expense of said improvement, including all necessary and incidental expenses shall be borne and assessed against the property included in the assessment district hereinafter created according to law.

ment District to be called Local Improvement District No. 71
which said district is described as follows:-

"All property between the termini of said improvement abutting upon, adjacent or approximate to said portion said protion of said street to a distance back from said marginal lines thereof as provided by law"

SECTION 3. Warrants bearing interest at the rate of 7% per cent. per annum shall be issued in payment of the cost and expense of said improvement, which warrants shall be redeemed and paid by collection of special assessments to be levied and assessed against the property in the Local Improvement District provided for herein, said assessment to be immediately due and payable upon the hearing and confirmation of the assessment roll.

SECTION 5. This ordinance shall be if full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
