

Ordinance Number 312.

An Ordinance prescribing and limiting the time of parking on certain streets on the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Kirkland, as follows;

Sec. 1. That no vehicles shall be allowed to park for more than 1/2 (one half) hour on either side of Lake Avenue South from its intersection with Kirkland Avenue to a line drawn west from the south side of the post Office, also on the South side of Kirkland Avenue for a distance of forty (40- feet) west of Lake Avenue.

Sec. 2. Vehicles shall be allowed to park all day on the South side of Lake Avenue for a distance of one hundred and sixty (160) feet west of the alley on the west side of the Lustig Building.

Sec. 3. Any thing in any other ordinance of the Town conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed.

Sec. 4 This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage, approval, and publication as required by law.
