

ORDINANCE O-4517

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SPECIAL
SIDEWALK USE REGULATIONS FOR PARK LANE.

1 WHEREAS, the City adopted temporary sidewalk use regulations
2 for a portion of Park Lane that will expire on June 7, 2016; and
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4 WHEREAS, the City would like to adopt permanent sidewalk use
5 regulations for the portion of Park Lane between Lake Street and Main
6 Street that supplement existing regulations applicable to all sidewalk
7 use.
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9 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland
10 ordains as follows:
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12 Section 1. A new Kirkland Municipal Code Section 19.04.069 is
13 hereby adopted to read as follows:
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15 **19.04.069 Special regulations for sidewalk use of a portion of**
16 **Park Lane.**

17 (a) The regulations set forth in this Section apply to the Park
18 Lane right of way between Lake Street and Main Street.

19 (b) Establishments with approved sidewalk cafes on Park Lane may
20 utilize surface demarcations to delineate the sidewalk cafe area from
21 the adjoining pedestrian corridor. Any establishment seeking to utilize
22 surface demarcations in lieu of a fence or other vertical barrier shall
23 comply with all applicable Washington Liquor Control Board regulations,
24 including but not limited to WAC 314-02-130. This Section supersedes
25 KMC 19.04.062(b) and KMC 19.04.065(a)(i).

26 (c) An establishment with an approved sidewalk cafe shall allow a
27 minimum five-foot wide unobstructed pedestrian corridor adjacent to
28 the sidewalk cafe area. This Section supersedes KMC 19.04.062(a).

29 (d) A retail establishment may use up to three feet of space along its
30 building frontage to display retail products for sale. A retail
31 establishment shall maintain a minimum six-foot wide unobstructed
32 pedestrian corridor adjacent to the retail display area.

33 (e) Except as provided in this Section, the provisions of the KMC
34 Sections 19.04.060 through 19.04.068 apply to all sidewalk uses.

35 (f) The minimum height for umbrellas and other shade devices shall
36 be seven feet in order to provide unobstructed passage for pedestrians.

37 (g) The Director of Public Works shall have the authority to approve
38 administrative regulations that supplement the regulations set forth in
39 this Section. Any supplementation of these regulations shall be based
40 on the City's observations and experience with respect to
41 implementation of this Section. The City shall promptly notify affected
42 establishments of any supplementation of the regulations in this Section.
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44 Section 2. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to
45 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the

46 ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or
47 circumstances is not affected.

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49 Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days
50 from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication,
51 as required by law.
