ORDINANCE NO. 362

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF FIRE CHIEF AND ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION OF THE CHIEF AND HIS ASSISTANTS, and PROVIDING FOR HIS APPOINTMENT. SECTION I.

BE IT ORDANIND by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland that there is hereby created the office of Fire Chief of the Town of Kirkland, to be appointed by the Mayor of said town with the approval of the Town Council.

SECTION II.

That the salery of the fire chief shall be the sum of \$50.00 per month.

SECTION III.

That the assistants to the fire chief shall be paid such amount as shall be approved by the Council for services rendered or to be rendered in the future, but no fixed salery shall be allowed.

SECTION IV.

This ordinance shall be in full force from and after its approval and publication as provided by law.
