

## ORDINANCE NO. 363

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CLERK TO ISSUE BONDS ON L.I.D. NO. 92 AND USE HIS BEST JUDGMENT AS TO THE SIZE OF SAID BONDS.

## SECTION I.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND That whereas warrants on L.I.D. No. 92 are held by different parties and in ~~xxx~~ such amounts that it will not be possible to make all bonds in the amount of Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars as provided by the general Local Improvement Ordinance, the Clerk is hereby authorized to have the bonds made in such amounts as will best serve the purpose of taking up all the outstanding warrants on said district.
