

ORDINANCE NO 366 1/2

AN ORDINANCE changing the names of certain streets in the Town of Kirkland and providing for numbering of houses.

BE IT ORDANNED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1, That Kirkland Avenue, Lake Avenue, Central Avenue and Market Street remain the same.

SECTION 2, That all other streets and avenues in the town of Kirkland be and the same are hereby changed to correspond with the provisions of this ordinance.

SECTION 3, That Kirkland Avenue be the dividing line between the North and South part of the Town.

SECTION 4, That all streets on the north of Kirkland Avenue and running East and West shall be designated as Avenues and numbered consecutively from First Ave upwards; and the streets running East and West being south of Kirkland Avenue shall be designated as Avenues South from First Avenue South upwards.

SECTION 5, That all streets running North and South shall be designated as Streets, The first street <sup>East</sup> ~~west~~ of Market which heretofore has been Bold Street shall be First Street and the next Second Street and so on upwards, and those South of Kirkland Avenue shall be designated the same with the addition of the word South.

SECTION 6, That syreets West of Market shall be designated as being West, those runninf North West from Market shall be

Avenues West and those running South West shall be streets West, that is to say; The street at present known as Waverly Street shall be <sup>Fourth</sup> First Avenue West and Park Street shall be First Street West, the next <sup>Fifth</sup> ~~Second~~ Ave and Second Street West as you go north. *and the succeeding avenues shall take the number of the nearest corresponding avenue on the east side of market street.*

SECTION 7. That every block shall be divided into numbers every Twenty (20) feet being entitled to a number, using Kirkland Avenue and Market Street as a dividing line. The numbers on the left of the street as you go north from Kirkland Avenue being odd and those on the right being even, that is, the first number on the left of <sup>First</sup> ~~Kirkland~~ Avenue would be 101 and on the right 100. The numbers south of Kirkland Avenue would be designated as South and those West of Market Street would be designated as West.

SECTION 8, This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication as required by law.
