

ORDINANCE NO. 367 $\frac{1}{2}$

AN ORDINANCE relating to the naming of streets, avenues and ways in the Town of Kirkland, Washington, adopting a system of numbering buildings and repealing all ordinance and parts of ordinances in conflict therewith.

THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the map hereinafter set out and embodied in this Ordinance and made a part hereof, showing the streets, avenues and ways in the Town of Kirkland, and showing the numeral system for the numbering of buildings in said Town is hereby approved and adopted; and the names of said streets, avenues and ways and the numeral system for the numbering of buildings as shown on said map are hereby adopted as the names of the streets, avenues and ways in said Town and said numeral system is hereby also adopted. Said streets, avenues and ways as shown on said map shall be hereafter known by the names as shown hereon, and shall be so designated; and the numeral system for the numbering of buildings, as shown on said map, shall be hereafter used for the numbering of all buildings on the streets, avenues and ways in said Town; and that all buildings in said Town having numbers conflicting with said numeral system shall be changed to correspond with said system as shown on said map.

Section 2. That said map is in the words and figures as follows, to-wit: -----MAP-----

Section 3. That all buildings shall be numbered according to the numeral system, as shown and designated on said map, allowing twenty (20) feet to each number.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from and after its passage and publication as provided by law.
