Ordinance No. 374

An ordinance declaring that an emergency exists in the fire department, on account of the complete brake down of the present fire truck, and estimating the amount of money necessary to meet said emergency and authorizing the issuance of emergency warrants for the initial payment on a new fire truck.

Be It Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland,

Section 1: That an emergency exists in the fire department on account of the complete brake down of the <sup>present</sup> fire truck, which endangers the life and property of the inhabitants of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2: That the purchase of a new fire truck is necessary for the protection of life and property of said Town and could not have been foreseen.

Section 3: That the estimated cost and expense of making the initial payment is the sum of \$1,000.00

Section 4: That the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay such warrants from any monies on hand in the Town treasury, in the funds chargeable with such expenditures. If any time there shall be insufficient money on hand to pay any emergency warrant, such warrant shall be registered and bear interest and be called in in the same

ORDINANCE NO. 374

Be it Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Kirkland

Section 1: That an emergency exists in the fire department on account of the complete brake down of the present fire truck, which endangers the life and property of the inhabitants of the Town of Kirkland.

Section 2: That the purchase of a new fire truck is necessary for the protection life and property of said Town and could not have been foreseen.

Section 3: That the estimated cost and expense of making the initial payment is the sum of \$1000.00

Section 4: That the Town Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay such warrants from any monies on hand in the Town treasury in the funds chargeable with such expenditure. If at any time there shall be money on hand to pay any emergency warrant, such warrant shall be registered and bear interest and be called in in the same manner as other town warrants.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage approval and publication as required by law.
