

*Repealed by Ord. 462*ORDINANCE NO. 375

An ordinance of the Town of Kirkland providing for the appointment of a building committee and requiring any person, firm or corporation desiring to erect any building or structure within the limits of the Town of Kirkland to procure a permit for such building or structure and to furnish plans and specifications if required.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION I. There is hereby created a committee to be known as the building committee, to be appointed by the Mayor with the approval of the Town Council.

SECTION II. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporations to erect any building or structure within the limits of the Town of Kirkland without first procuring a permit from the building committee, hereinabove referred to.

SECTION III. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporations to make any additions or alterations to any buildings or structures within the limits of the Town of Kirkland without first procuring from the building committee, hereinabove referred to, a permit to make such additions or alterations.

SECTION IV. Any person, firm or corporations violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction be punished by a fine not less than \$5.00 or more than \$300.00.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect, from and after its passage, approval and publication, as provided by law.
