

AN ORDINANCE of the Town of Kirkland regulating the use of bicycles within the limits of the Town of Kirkland and prescribing a penalty for violation thereof.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle double, that is to say, mor than one person being on the said bicycle at the same time on Lake Avenue from Market Street to Second Avenue South and on Kirkland Avenue from Lake Avenue to the City Limits.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle on the sidewalk in the above named streets.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle within the limits of the Town of Kirkland one hour after sunset or one hour before sun rise without having a white or yellow light on the front which is visible for a distance of two hundred feet and a red light or reflector on the rear whixh is visable for a distance of two hundred feet from the rear.

Section 4. Any person riding a bicycle on the sidewalks within the limits of the Town of Kirkland shall give the right of way to a person or persons walking on saide sidewalk.

Section 5. Any person violating any provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and be fined in any sum not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars and (or) be restrained from riding a bicycle within the limits for a period of not more than one year.
