ORDINANCE FOR VACATION OF PORTION OF A STREET

In the matter of the petition of Grace A. Wolf et al. for the vacation of a portion of a street in Kirkland, King County, Washington

ORDINANCE NO. 392

A petition having been filed by Grace A. Wolf, et al., including ten free holders of King County, Washington, for the vacation of a strip of land twenty (20) feet in width lying immediately westerly of and adjacent to Lots One (1), Two (2), Three (3) and Four (4) in Block Thirty-two (32), Blewett's First Addition to Kirkland, according to plat recorded in volume 6 of plats, page 82, records of King County, Washington, and it appearing that written notice of said vacation has been posted in three of the most public places in Kirkland, Washington, and that one notice thereof was posted on said twenty foot strip of land, and it appearing that said twenty foot strip is no longer needed as a street, and that the public will not be in any way injured by the vacation thereof, it is now ordered that said 20 foot strip of land be vacated as a public street.
