Ordinance No. 395.

An Ordinance to amend Section XIV of Ordinance No. 311 of the Town of Kirkland, entitled "An Ordinance relating to Local Improvements in the Town of Kirkland."

Be it ordained by the Council of the Town of Kirkland:

Section 1. That Section XIV of Ordinance No. 311 of the Town of Kirkland, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows;

"Section XIV: Delinquent Assessments; Foreclosure, Whenever on the first day of January of any year two installments of any local improvement assessment payable by the mode of "Payment by Bonds" shall be delinquent, or the final installment of any such assessment, or any assessment payable by the mode of "Immediate Payment" shall have been delinquent for more than one year, the Town Treasurer shall, on or before the first day of September of such year, proceed with the foreclosure of all such delinquent assessments or installments ~~thereof~~ thereof, as the case may be, by proceedings in court therefor in an action brought in the name of the Town of Kirkland in the Superior Court of the State of Washington for King County, as provided by law."

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
