ORDINANCE NO. 399.

An Ordinance declaring that it is not unlawful for regularly licensed physicians, dentists and druggists to transport, possess, prescribe or dispense medicinal liquor when permitted by the laws of the United States, and repealing provisions in conflict herewith.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND.

Section 1. It is hereby declared that it is not unlawful for any duly licensed physician, dentist or druggist to transport, possess, prescribe or dispense medicinal liquor, when they have been duly authorized so to do by the laws of the United States and all rules and regulations promulgated pursuant thereto by the proper authorities.

Section 2. So far as any provisions of Ordinances No. 7, No. 42 and No. 236 are in conflict herewith the same are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in the manner provided by law.
