ORDINANCE NO. 4//

An ordinance regulating motor vehicle trafic at certain street intersections in the Town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND: Section 1.

The operator of any motor vehicle on the streets of the Town of Kirkland approaching any street intersection, shall come to a full stop before entering into or upon such intersection, when and where signs, posts or other markers so direct.

Section 2.

Any person violating the foregoing provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction ty cents for the first violation: and for a second or any subsequent that it is punished by a fine of not more than \(\frac{1}{\infty}\) \(\frac{1}{\infty}\) oco \(\frac{1}{\infty}\), or by imprisonment in the Town jail for not to exceed 30 —

days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.

Section 5.

This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage, approval and publication.
