Repealed ONDINANCE NO. 4.12...

An ordinance relating to the licensing and regulating of automobiles and other motor vehicles engaged in carrying passengers for hire in the City of Kirkland and repasling all ordinances or parts thereof in conflict:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, as follows:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 291 be repealed and that Section 4 of Ordinance 161 be reinstated and amended to read as follows:

Every person owning or having an equitable title to any automobile or automobiles and who is engaged in the business of operating a motor vehicle for hire in the city of Kirkland, as in Ordinance 161 described shall pay the following license fee for the privilege of engaging in said business:

For the first automobile or for hire car \$.0.00... For each additional automobile or for hire car \$5.00

Licenses shall be issued as of the 1st day of October and shall be valid for a period of one year, unless cancelled or revoked. All licenses shall be issued by the town treasurer and the treasurer shall renew licenses from year to year by noting the fact of such renewal upon the license. Each license shall be numbered and shall bear the date and year of issuance.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 211 shall be repealed and Section 6 of Ordinance 161 shall be reinstated and amended to read as follows:

All motor vehicles for hire shall confine their parking positions to the north side of the ferry slip except that the Redmond stage may continue maintaining it place on the south side of the Kirkland ferry slip at such a place or position as designated by the chief city marshal.
