

ORDINANCE NO. 414

An ordinance creating an arterial highway within the city limits of the town of Kirkland.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND.

I

Central Avenue, from and including the intersection of 9th Avenue Street, thence West to the intersection of Central Avenue and Lake Street, shall be from the time that this ordinance goes into effect an arterial highway.

II

All streets intersecting said portion of Central Avenue, with the exception of Lake Street, shall be deemed streets approaching an arterial, and all drivers of automobile vehicles or any other vehicle or vehicles shall make a full stop immediately prior to entering upon said arterial highway from a street intersecting said arterial as above described, and shall yield the right of way to vehicles on such arterial highway.

III

The day marshal for the Town of Kirkland is hereby authorized and directed to erect in fit and proper places stop signs at the points of intersection above referred to.

IV

Any person violating the foregoing provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the city jail for not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the court.
