ORDINANCE NO. 422

An Ordinance of the Town of Kirkland, creating the office of Cashier for the Water Department of the Town of Kirkland and fixing the salary of said officer.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF KIRKLAND that

1. There shall be appointed by the Mayor a Cashier for the Water Department of the Town of Kirkland, which officer shall hold office during the pleasure of the Mayor.
2. The Cashier of the Water department shall collect all of the accounts of the Kirkland Water Department and shall do and perform all clerical work necessary and incidental to said office.
3. The salary of the Cashier of the Water Department shall be and hereby is fixed at the sum of Thirteen hundred dollars per year, (\$1300.00), payable in equal monthly installments.
