

ORDINANCE NO. 435

AN ORDINANCE VACATING CERTAIN STREET PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the petition to vacate that certain alley between Lots 36 to 44 inclusive and Lots 48 to 50 inclusive, Block 103, Burke & Farrar's Kirkland business center addition, division No. 25, County of King, State of Washington, be and it is hereby granted.

This ordinance is passed in pursuance of the original petition, filed with the clerk of the City of Kirkland on the 15th day of November, 1937 and signed by the owners of more than two-thirds of the private property abutting upon the said alley, which portion of said alley to be vacated is fully described in the said petition.

Due and proper notice of the pendency of the said petition to vacate the above mentioned alley in the City of Kirkland, was formally given as required by law, the 19th day of February, 1940 being the date set for the hearing of the above-mentioned petition.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED; that the plat filed with the City Clerk of Kirkland relating to the vacation of the said street property is hereby approved.
