ORDINANCE NO. 441

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION NUMBER 17, ORDINANCE NUMBER 222, WHICH ORDINANCE PROVIDES RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE USE OF CITY WATER BY CITIZENS OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 17 of Ordinance No. 222, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Commencing January 1, 1941, Meter rates for water in the City of Kirkland shall be sold by the City and paid by consumers at the following rate:

- 1. For the first 1000 cubic feet or less per month \$1.50.
- 2. All water used in excess of 1000 but not exceeding 10,000 cubic feet, shall be charged at the rate of .60¢ per 1000 cubic feet or a fraction thereof.
- 3. All water sold in excess of 10,000 cubic feet, shall be charged at the rate of .40¢ per 1000 cubic feet or a fraction thereof.

The following rates shall be charged for water sold outside of the City Limits of the City of Kirkland:

- 1. For the first 1000 cubic feet or less per month \$2.00.
- 2. All water sold in excess of 1000 cubic feet, regardless of the amount consumed, shall be charged at the rate of .60¢ per 1000 cubic feet or a fraction thereof.

Bills for water due, shall be paid on the 1st day of each and every month. If bills are not paid by the 15th of any month on which a bill is due, the water will be shut off without notice and not turned on again until all arrears are paid together with an additional fee of .50%.
