## ORDINANCE

## NO.441

AN ORDINANCE FORBIDDING SOLICITORS, PEDDLERS, HAWKERS, ITINERANT MERCHANTS AND TRANSIENT VENDORS OF MERCHANDISE FROM TRESPASSING IN AND UPON PRIVATE RESIDENCES WHEN UNINVITED SO TO DO BY THE OWNERS AND OCCUPANTS OF SAID PRIVATE RESIDENCE, IN SOLICITING AND ATTEMPTING TO SOLICIT ORDERS, OR IN SELLING AND EXPOSING FOR SALE WARES AND MERCHANDISE, AND DECLARING SUCH SOLICITING TO BE A NUISANCE, AND DIRECTING THE POLICE AUTHORITIES TO ABATE SUCH NUISANCES, AND FIXING THE PENALTY FOR COMMITTING SUCH NUISANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The practice of going in and upon private residences in the City of Kirkland, Washington, by solicitors, peddlers, hawkers, iminerant merchants and transient vendors of merchandise, not having been requested or invited so to do by the owner of owners, occupant or occupants of said private resi-dence, for the purpose of soliciting orders for the sale of goods, wares and merchandise, and /or for the purpose of disposing of and /or peddling or hawking the same is hereby declared to be a nuisance, and punishable as such nuisance as a misdemeanor,

Section 2. The chief of police and the police force of the City of Kirkland, are hereby required and directed to suppress the same, and to abate any such nuisance as is described in the first section of this ordinance,

Section 3. Any person convicted of perpetrating a nuisance as described and prohibited in the first section of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof shall be fined a sum not less than \$25.00 or not more than \$100.00, together with costs of proceeding, which said fine may be satisfied, if not paid in cash, by execution against the person of anyone convicted of committing the misdemensor herein prohibited.

Ordinance ho. 389 and Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conglict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
