ORDINANCE

No. 458

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGULATION OF HEAT IN APARTMENTS AND BUSINESS-STORE BUILDINGS IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

1. In all business-store buildings and apartment houses where the lessor is under a responsibility by agreement to furnish heat for said premises, and where no specific temperature is provided for in said agreement, the following shall be the minimum temperature required for said premises, during the months of October to April, inclusive, in each year.

(a) Business Premises: 60° F. temperature by 9:00 o'clock of each business-day morning; 65° F. temperature by 10:00 o'clock of each business-day morning; and 65° F. temperature from 10:00 o'clock to the end of each business day.

(b) Apartment Houses: 60° F. temperature by 9:00 o'clock of each morning; 68° F. temperature by 10:30 o'clock of each morning and continuing to 10:30 o'clock at night, every day during said period.

Any person who shall be found to have violated this Ordinance, except where the violation thereof is caused by circumstances beyond the control of the person charged with responsibility thereof, shall be fined a sum not to exceed One Hundred and Fifty Dollars (\$150.00).
