ORDINANCE No._467

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CREATING THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER FOR THE KIRKLAND WATER DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FIXING THE DUTIES AND SALARY OF SAID OFFICER AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES MCONSISTENT THEREWITH.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

- 1. Ordinance No. 439 and all other ordinances in consistence herewith are hereby repealed, effective Dec.1,1942.
- 2. There shall be and there hereby is appointed by the Mayor of the City of Kirkland, an administrative officer of the City of Kirkland, known and hereafter to be described as Administrative Officer for the Mater Department of the City of Kirkland.
- 3. The duties and responsibilities of the said Administrative Officer are as follows:
- (a) All complaints to the Kirkland City Water Department not within the scope and duty of the Clerk of the Water Department, or the Superintendent of the Water Department, or the City Attorney, shall be referred to said Officer for action.
- (b) He shall, at the request of the Mayor, the City Council, or the Water Superintendent, prepare and submit to the City Council statements and reports showing the operation and efficiency of conduct of the Water Department.
- (c) He shall attend all conferences and meetings when requested by the Mayor, whereby the Water Department of the City of Kirkland is affected and when, in the opinion of the Mayor, it is necessary that the interests of the said Water Department be sustained and protected, by the presence of said Administrative Officer, at said meeting or meetings.
- 4. The salary for this position shall be and hereby is fixed at the sum of \$1700.00 per year, payable in equal monthly installments, commencing Dec. 1, 1942.
