

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CREATING THE OFFICE OF CHIEF OF POLICE AND FIXING THE SALARY FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NOS. 421 AND 431.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That there be and hereby is established, for the City of Kirkland, a Police Department, which Department shall consist of Chief of Police, and, if and when needed, one or more patrolmen.

That the salary of the Chief of Police be and hereby is established at the sum of Twenty Four Hundred Dollars (\$2400.00) per annum, payable in equal monthly installments.

That the salary for the patrolmen of said Department be and hereby is established at the sum of Twenty One Hundred Dollars (\$2100.00), payable in equal monthly installments.

That Ordinances Nos. 421 and 431 and all other ordinances inconsistent herewith be and they hereby are repealed.
