ORDINANCE

No. 474

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CREATING THE OFFICE OF ASSISTANT CLERK FOR THE SEWER DEPARTMENT, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES FOR SAID OFFICE AND ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR SAID OFFICE

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. That there be and hereby is created the office of Assistant Clerk for the Sewer Department in and for the City of Kirkland.

2. That the duties and responsibilities for said office shall be to assist and aid the Clerk for said Sewer Department in the performance of all duties of the Clerk of said Department.

3. That the salary for this position shall be and hereby is fixed at the sum of Three Hundred Sixty Dollars (\$360.00) per annum, payable in equal monthly installments, for so long as the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per month is paid to the Special Clerk for the Kirkland Sewer Project, as provided by Ordinance No. 454.

4. That when, in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance No. 454, the Special Clerk for the Kirkland Sewer Project shall no longer receive the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) monthly, pursuant to said Ordinance, then there shall be paid to the Assistant Clerk for the Sewer Department the sum of Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) per annum, payable in equal monthly installments.
