ORDINANCE

No. 476

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND PROVIDING COMPENSATION FOR THE MAYOR AND MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR ATTENDING COUNCIL MEETINGS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Mayor and each member of the City Council in and for the City of Kirkland shall be entitled to receive the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each meeting of the City Council which he attends, provided, however, that such compensation shall in no event be paid to the Mayor or any member of the City Council for attendance of more than two (2) Council Meetings in any one month.
- 2. And provided further that the compensation herein provided for shall not be paid to the present Mayor of the City of Kirkland or to his successor during his present term in office, nor to any present member of the City Council or his successor during his present term in office.
