ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE SALARY OF THE POLICE JUDGE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO 408.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the salary of the Police Judge in and for the City of Kirkland shall be and is hereby fixed at Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) per annum.

That Ordinance No. 408 and all other Ordinances inconsistent herewith be and hereby are repealed.

That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after the 1st day of December, 1942.
