ORDINANCE

No. 479

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CREATING AND ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF THE SEWER DEPARTMENT, FIXING THE DUTIES AND ESTABLISHING THE SALARY THEREOF AND REPEALING IN PART ORDINANCE NO. 457.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That there be and hereby is created the office of Superintendent of sewers in and for the City of Kirkland;

That the duties of said office shall be to do and perform or supervise the doing and performing of all the acts necessary to the maintenance and operation of the sewer system in and for the City of Kirkland;

That the salary for said office shall be the sum of Twenty Four Hundred Dollars (\$2400.00) per annum, payable in equal monthly installments;

That Ordinance No. 457 heretofore passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 29th day of December, 1941, is hereby expressly repealed in so far as said Ordinance, by Section No. 6, directs that one and the same person shall be superintendent of the Water Department and of the Sewer Department in and for the City of Kirkland, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
