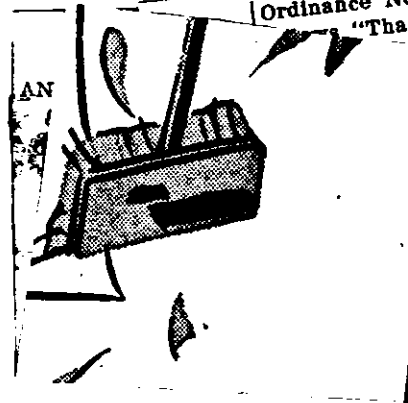

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR THE SUPERINTENDENT OF SEWERS AND THE SUPERINTENDENT OF WATER IN AND FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AND REPEALING IN PART ORDINANCE No. 479 AND ORDINANCE No. 465

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the salary of the Water Superintendent of the City of Kirkland be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month.

2. That the salary of the Sewer Superintendent of the City of Kirkland be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00) per month.

3. That Section No. 1 of Ordinance No. 465, reading as follows: "That the salary of the Water Superintendent of the City of Kirkland be and the same is hereby fixed at the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per month." be and the same is hereby repealed.

4. That Paragraph No. 3 of Ordinance No. 479, reading as follows: "That the salary for said office shall be the sum of Twenty Four Hundred Dollars (\$2400.00) per annum, payable in equal monthly installments." be and the same hereby is repealed, and all other ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be December 1, 1943.
