ORDINANCE

No. 492

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FIXING THE COMPENSATION FOR MEMBERS OF THE CITY COUNCIL IN AND FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That to each person hereafter elected to the City Council in and for the City of Kirkland there shall be paid the sum of Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each Council Meeting, whether regular or special, attended; provided, however, such payments as aforesaid shall not be made for more than two (2) council meetings in any one calendar month.
